CHECKLIST BEFORE ACRA REGISTRATION

After you've chosen the right business structure, you can register your business with the the Accounting and Corporate Regulatory Authority (ACRA) – www.acra.gov.sg

But before you do so, have you...

1. Met ACRA's Eligibility Requirement?

For Sole-Proprietors, Partnerships, LLPs and LPs

- · Owner(s) must be aged 18 years or above
- Singapore citizen / PR / Employment Pass or Dependent Pass holder (Foreigners can appoint a local manager)
- Have not been declared bankrupt (Undischarged bankrupts must receive court approval)

For Companies (Private and Public)

- At least one director and one shareholder (can be the same person)
- · Directors must be aged 18 years or above
- Have not been declared bankrupts or convicted of dishonesty

2. Checked your Business Name Availability?

Business names are not approved if its:

- Identical to another on the registry (Search at ACRA's online directory of businesses)
- · Obscene or contain vulgarities
- Already reserved

3. Found your SSIC Code?

- The Singapore Standard Industry Classification code (SSIC) is ACRA's way of categorising businesses
- Search for the right SSIC code using ACRA's online search engine

5. Cleared your Outstanding Medisave Liabilities?

- You must first pay up your Medisave liabilities or have arranged for payment by instalments before starting your business
- Find out your outstanding Medisave liabilities from the CPF Board's website

4. Found a Local Business Address?

- The location must be approved for business use by the Urban Redevelopment Authority (URA)
- P.O. boxes cannot be used as place of business
- Residential properties can only be used under the Home Office Scheme
- *find out more about approved business locations at ura.gov.sg

6. Applied for Necessary Licenses & Permits?

- Certain types of businesses such as private schools, childcare centres and video companies require licences and permits
- Use the Online Business Licensing Service (OBLS) to register your business and apply for licences and permits at one go

PICKING YOUR CORPORATE BANK ACCOUNT

Which Bank should you choose?


